Context

Children are our most precious asset. They are one third of our population and are the architects of the future of our nation. There is increasing concern about the issues related to children. Preventing and responding to violence and exploitation against children is essential to ensuring their right to protection. The Integrated Child Protection Scheme (ICPS) and Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 introduced by Government of India bring together multiple existing child protection schemes under one comprehensive umbrella and institutionalize services and strengthen structures at all levels.

Capacity building of the various functionaries is one of the key components of ICPS. It emphasizes on building capacities at all levels of service providers and places importance on developing technical expertise through trainings of personnel in allied systems, departments concerned and various stakeholders under child protection systems.

In this backdrop, the Child Resource Centre is being established as an exclusive centre towards knowledge dissemination, convergence and capacity development of all stakeholders responsible for child protection.

About

The Child Resource Centre (CRC) is a strategic initiative with focus on capacity building of all stakeholders in child protection systems and creation of a knowledge hub. It is a joint venture of Rajasthan State Child Protection Society (RSCPS) under the aegis of Department for Child Rights, Rajasthan (DCR) and Harish Chandra Mathur Rajasthan State Institute of Public Administration (HCM RIPA) with initial technical support from UNICEF.
